Diane grew up in Bethlehem UCC and participated in many lay


ministries and boards of the church including Christian Education, Fellowship, Elder, mission trips, and lay reader.

committed to local affordable housing and building strength, stability and new lives through our local Habitat for Humanity. Our volunteer day is scheduled for Saturday, September 10, 9:00 - 4:00.

Eight volunteers are needed. BUCC, along with other area churches and community volunteers, are revitalizing 1104 Parkwood Ave in Ypsilanti. The house is a two-story home, and it will be matched with a family shortly since the family helps with the remodeling (250 hours). No construction experience is needed to volunteer. Projects will vary, but may include light demolition, insulation, blue board, house wrap, and perhaps painting or landscaping.

All you need to bring is sturdy closed-toe shoes and a can-do spirit! No experience is necessary, age 16 and up can participate.

\$135,000. Materials cost \$1,000 per build day and some money is also used to pay contractors. We hope to give a generous donation towards these costs.


